



# Cleaning and Maintenance Instructions

## IMPORTANT

Please read prior to installation and use

MOKU Limestone Basins are a natural stone product which require careful maintenance.

### CLEANING

Only clean with warm soapy water and a soft cloth.

Never use scourers or other abrasive cleaning agents as this will damage the stone and remove the sealant used to waterproof the stone. This will lead to staining and the polished surface becoming dull and scratched.

### MAINTENANCE

Moku Limestone basins should be resealed at least once a year with a suitable sealant. These are readily available from reputable stone care merchants.

## KNOWLEDGE AND CARE ADVICE

All MOKU basins are treated with a water repellent sealant that penetrates the surface of the stone to help repel liquids.

**IMPORTANT: Acids and Alkalis may destroy the water repellent seal and polish layer.**

You can care for your MOKU Limestone basin easily by following the simple advice below.

- Clean the stone regularly using a soft cloth or sponge with non-abrasive PH neutral detergent and warm water. Rinse and dry after cleaning.
- Do not use the following on your stone basin:
  - Acidic Tub & Tile Cleaners
  - Acidic Toilet Bowl Cleaners
  - Ammonia
  - Powdered Abrasive Cleaners
  - Soft Paste Cleaners
  - Vinegar
  - Alcohol
  - Window Cleaners
  - Abrasive Cleaning Pads
  - Lemon or Citrus cleaners
- Do not rub the stone with abrasive cleaning materials like scouring powders, steel wool, metal brushed etc.
- Wipe up spills immediately, especially liquids that have the potential to stain.
- Do not allow surface deposits to build up eg. powered detergent, salts, standing water, limescale.
- Protect your stone surface with professional stone sealer regularly.
